Directions

Misenheimer is located less than one hour northeast of Charlotte. Charlotte and Greensboro (the two nearest major metropolitan areas) both have major airports, train and bus service. Pfeiffer is located on U.S. Highway 52 between Salisbury and Albemarle. All visitors should arrive at the Welcome Center, where they will begin their campus tour.

From I-85 in Salisbury, take exit 76 and follow U.S. Highway 52 South for 16 miles. When you arrive on campus, turn left onto Merner Terrance after you pass the Pfeiffer chapel.

From Charlotte's eastern city limits, take U.S. Highway 49 north for 30 miles. At the intersection of Highway 52 and Highway 49 turn left. Campus is one mile north on Highway 52. Turn onto Merner Terrace on your right, just before Pfeiffer's chapel.

From Asheboro, take U.S. Highway 49 South for 30 miles. At the intersection of Highway 52 and Highway 49, turn right. Campus is one mile north on Highway 52. Turn onto Merner Terrace on your right, just before Pfeiffer's chapel.

Once you are on campus, park in the visitor parking spots behind the Pfeiffer chapel. The Office of Admissions is in the Welcome Center, which is behind the Administration Building.
