COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

Dr. David P. Cartrette

Associate Professor of Chemistry & Faculty Senate Chair Pfeiffer University



David Cartrette is an Associate Professor of Chemistry at Pfeiffer University. He grew up in Apex, NC, and attended all the public schools Apex had to offer (elementary, middle, and high). He earned a B.S. in Biochemistry and a B.A. in Chemistry from North Carolina State University and remains to this day a Wolfpack fan through the thickest and thinnest of times. After working a dead-end job or two, he continued his education by earning a M.S. in Chemistry from Western Carolina, and a Ph.D. in Curriculum and Instruction from Purdue University. It was during his time at Western that his vocation found him: teaching organic chemistry. Dr. C., as he is known, has pursued that vocation for more than 20 years at various institutions of higher learning, coming to Pfeiffer University in 2017. He has been recognized for achievements in teaching, research, and service through awards from the American Chemical Society and the National Science Foundation.

Outside of academics, Dr. C. is passionate about cooking, enjoying the company of good friends, taking road trips in foreign countries, trying to improve his piano playing skills, and Sunday afternoon naps.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The formal academic dress worn today originated more than 600 years ago. The apparel has changed little in appearance but has taken on a significant role in identifying the degree and alma mater of its wearer.

Gowns for those with bachelor's degrees have pointed sleeves; those with master's degrees wear oblong sleeves and holders of doctoral degrees wear bell-shaped sleeves. Doctoral gowns have velvet facing on the front and three velvet stripes on each side. Hoods indicate the colors of the institution from which the degree was received and the color of the hood's border represents the academic discipline in which the degree was earned.
