Pfeiffer University's Pfeiffer Pact has now expanded to include ALL North Carolina community colleges. This initiative allows students to transfer to Pfeiffer with a guaranteed pathway to degree completion. Admissions is also guaranteed with a 2.5 GPA, along with an automatic \$20,000 Pfeiffer Pact Scholarship, renewable annually!

Requirements

- An associate's degree from a NC community college with a GPA of at least a 2.5
- Elementary Education requires at least a 2.75
- Nursing requires a separate application to be admitted in their upper division program
- Be in good academic standing with the community college you are transferring from
- Complete the FREE Pfeiffer transfer application



Pfeiffer Pact Student Information

- A student entering Pfeiffer University with an earned associate's degree from a NC community
 college as will be designated a "transfer student" and will be registered with Junior class status at
 Pfeiffer University, with all the privileges and benefits available to students already enrolled at
 Pfeiffer University, including application for financial assistance, eligibility for academic degree
 honors (e.g. Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude), student activities, development services, and social
 opportunities. This applies to all undergraduate programs listed in Appendix A, regardless of the
 mode of delivery.
- Students must hold a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale to be eligible for regular transfer admission to Pfeiffer University. Students who hold a GPA of 2.0 to 2.5 may be eligible for conditional admission, which includes an interview by the Pfeiffer Admissions staff.
- Students entering one of the Elementary Education pathways must hold a GPA of 2.75 or higher for admission.
- Students can be accepted to the University on the Nursing pathway. However, in addition to
 admission to the university, students must apply and be admitted to the nursing upper division
 program to take nursing courses leading to the BSN degree.
- A student transferring to Pfeiffer University under this agreement will transfer academic credits earned at the participating community college with the grade C- and above, Pfeiffer University does not accept grades of D from any transfer students.
- Students must be in good academic standing for admission into Pfeiffer University. Good academic standing is verified through the student's transcript.
- Students must successfully complete their community college degree program prior to transfer, with a maximum of 64 semester hours allowed in transfer to Pfeiffer University.
- Students must complete a Pfeiffer University transfer student application (free of charge). Students must complete the transfer application process and provide all required documents prior to acceptance into Pfeiffer University.
- Students who meet the criteria outlined in this agreement will receive Guaranteed Admission into Pfeiffer University.
- Students in the traditional programs who have at least a 2.5 GPA will automatically receive a \$20,000 per year Transfer Scholarship. Online students who have at least a 2.5 GPA will receive a 20% discount. Students in the online RN to BSN pathway who have at least a 2.5 GPA will be charged \$189 per credit hour. Students entering the traditional Elementary Education pathways must hold a GPA of 2.75 or higher for admission and to receive the automatic \$20,000 per year Transfer Scholarship. Online students in the Elementary Education pathway must also hold a GPA of 2.75 or higher for admission and to receive the 20% discount for that program.
